There will be few changes unless one of us has already spoken to you. Also, this document is open to changes throughout the year so contact us at anytime should you have any concerns.

The support available includes Indirect support (classroom accommodations and progress monitored) and direct support (classroom accommodations, individual/small group work, assistance from an Educational Assistant and/or resource time).

It is to the student's advantage to make use of the assistance available to him/her so we ask for your support in discussing the benefits of resource support and encouraging your son or daughter to take full advantage.
